



Tips for Fire Fighter Outreach

Reaching Out to Fire Fighters in Your Community

There are multiple opportunities to provide the *To Hell and Back II* situational awareness training program for fire fighters in your community. Each department across the country has different community dynamics that will dictate the best methods for reaching out to fellow fire fighters. Utilize methods you believe will be the most effective in getting this important program into your training cycles.

Below are a few opportunities you may want to consider as starting points as you begin to raise awareness about your department's participation in and training classes offered using *To Hell and Back II* situational awareness:

- Organize a *regional* training program / opportunity
- Contact your local Chiefs Council organizations who can take the information back to individual departments and request training opportunities
- For on-call or volunteer fire departments, use your once or twice a month meetings as a FREE training class opportunity (for all ages, abilities and years of service)
- Outreach to Fire Explorer / Junior Firefighter program (make the program a basic requirement for all NEW members to the organization)
